Turning Tools-face turning (bowls)

- 1 3/8" Bowl Gouge 3/8" flute (The way Sorby measures, not One-Way)
- 2 Parting Tool-Diamond
- 3 Profile Scraper 1"x3/8"
- 4 Round-Nose Scraper ½ "

Turning Tools-spindle turning (pens, etc.)

- 1 Roughing Gouge 1" or larger
- 2 Spindle Gouge 3/8" flute
- 3 Parting Tool-Diamond
- 4 ½" square scraper

- 1 Thin Parting Tool
- 2 Skew $\frac{1}{2}$ " $\frac{3}{4}$ "
- 3 Hollowing Tools
- 4 Bedan
- 5 Fingernail Grind Gouges
- 6 Detail Gouge

Also, the thread size for your lathe....example 1 ¼ x 8tpi...(means diameter then threads per inch..... you will need this for purchase of a chuck adapter.
